LRADAC provides services for all, regardless of ability to pay. Money can be a primary barrier to participating in treatment.

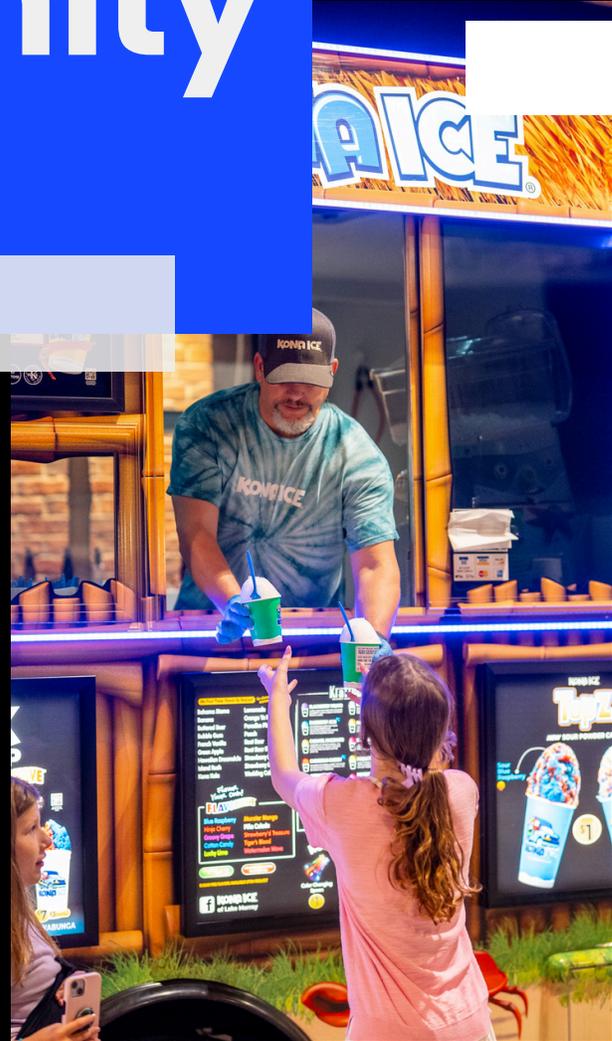
LRADAC Foundation helps provide recovery assistance for uninsured patients or those facing financial hardships – helping pay for assessments, treatment and other recovery programs.

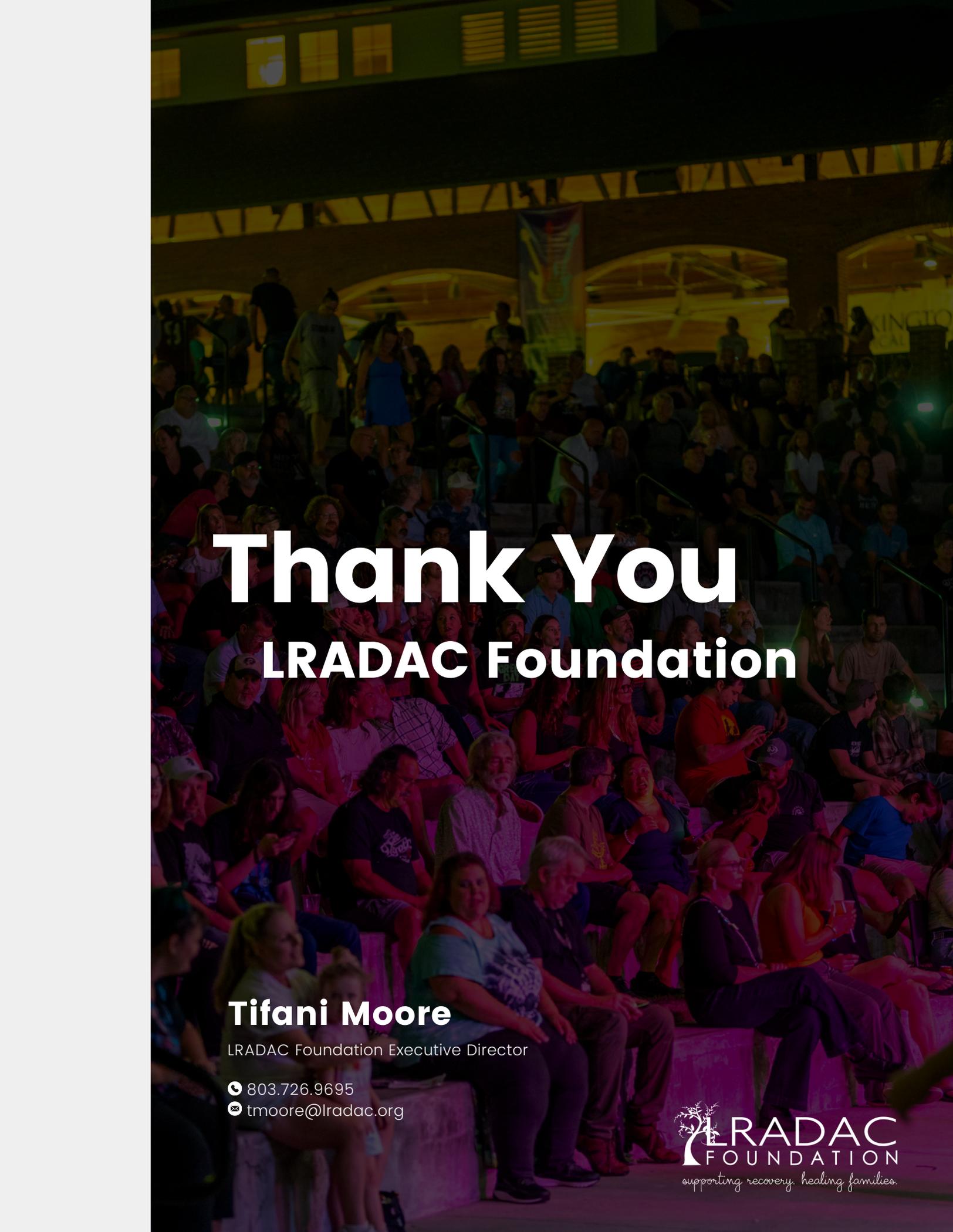
